<u>Section 1</u>. That the following right of way, to-wit:

A portion of Cleveland Street right of way located between

Vine Street and Ash Street, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is the northeast corner of BYRTENSHAW ADDITION to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, said point lies on the southwest corner of the south boundary of the Cleveland Street right of way between Vine Street and Ash Street; thence East 60.0 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 5, Block 4, PARK ADDITION to said city; thence North 52.5 feet along the east boundary of said lot; thence West 60.0 feet; thence South 52.5 feet to the point of beginning.

SAVE AND EXCEPT a 15 foot wide easement adjacent to the west boundary of the parcel described herein for construction, maintenance, repair, and or replacement of municipal utility lines.
