ORDINANCE NO. 2059

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:


Section 1. A new Section 6.12.015 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is enacted to read as follows:

6.12.015. Number of Dogs Per Dwelling Unit.

No person shall keep, own or have charge of more than two adult dogs over the age of eight months in or upon any premises within the City of Lebanon. For the purposes of this Section, "premises" includes any building or dwelling unit, as defined by Section 17.04.210 of this Code, and any surrounding real property of the same, whether privately or publicly owned.

Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this Bill shall not apply to any person who has come into control of more than two adult dogs prior to the effective date of this Bill.
