SECTION 13.04.180 OF THE LEBANON) for 1989  
MUNICIPAL CODE AND DECLARING AN ) ORDINANCE NO. 2065  
EMERGENCY )

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 13.04.180 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

A service charge shall be paid to the City whenever water service is turned on after having been turned off due to non-payment or by request of the customer. For purposes of this Section, turn-off for non-payment shall mean the processing of the work order which instructs system personnel to shut off service.


However, no turn-on charge shall be imposed during normal working hours if service is turned off at customer request, and if a customer shut-off valve is installed adjacent to the meter by and at the expense of the customer. If water service is turned off for the convenience of the city, no turn-on charge will be assessed at any time. If water is turned off due to an emergency of the customer, such as a broken pipe, no turn-on charge will be imposed for water turn-on during normal working hours or at other times regularly scheduled for such purpose. However, the normal after-hours service charge shall be made for the turn-on of water service after hours, on weekends, or at such other times not regularly scheduled by the City.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
