DECLARING AN EMERGENCY)	ORDINANCE NO. <u>2084</u>

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for Linn County has initiated a proceeding for the transfer of jurisdiction of certain County roads within the City of Lebanon, and such proceedings have resulted in Order No. 90-597 which offers to surrender jurisdiction over County roads within the City of Lebanon described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and such Order reciting that if the City of Lebanon, by appropriate municipal legislation enacted prior to October 31, 1990, accepts said offer that the Board of County Commissioners will surrender full and absolute jurisdiction over the roads described in Exhibit "A"; and the City of Lebanon hereby deems it necessary, expedient and for the best interest of the City to acquire jurisdiction over the County roads listed in Exhibit "A" to the same extent as the City has over other public streets and alleys of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, the people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The City of Lebanon hereby accepts the County Order, No. 90-597, and the accompanying offer to surrender jurisdiction of the County roads within the City of Lebanon described in Exhibit "A", pursuant to the provisions of ORS 373.280.

Section 2. It is hereby determined that it is necessary and expedient and for the best interests of the City to acquire jurisdiction over said County roads.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 24th day of October, 1990.



703	Hansard Avenue	From SPTC crossing North to the terminus of County Road No. 703. (Approximately 1700 feet)
10	Oak Street	From Seventh Street West to the current west city limits. (Approximately 5000 feet)
