THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 12.12.041 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby enacted to read as follows:

12.12.041 Reservation System.


The use of the city parks shelter areas may be reserved for private functions by individuals or groups. A standard form shall be completed for each reservation and approved by the City Administrator or his designee.

A non-refundable fee may be established by resolution of City Council and may be charged for reservation of a shelter for private use. The fee may be waived by the City Administrator or designee for public use.

It shall be unlawful for anyone to interfere with or prohibit the use of a park shelter by the reserved party.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 4 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 14th day of August, 1991.
