THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Lebanon Municipal Code, Section 13.04.091, is hereby enacted to read as follows:

13.04.091 CHARGE FOR BAD CHECKS


At the discretion of the City Administrator, a fee may be imposed when a check is returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

SECTION 2. Lebanon Municipal Code, Section 13.04.315, is hereby enacted to read as follows:


13.04.315 UTILITY RATE REVIEW COMMITTEE

The City shall establish a Utility Rate Review Committee consisting of two members of the City Council, and members of the public who are rate payers of the system or other interested parties. The committee shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Mayor. The committee shall meet annually to review the financial and physical condition of the water and wastewater systems and, if necessary, make recommendations to the City Council regarding the systems.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 26th day of February, 1992.
