The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.44.100 of the Lebanon Municipal Code, Sidewalk Riding Prohibited Where, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (a) No person, other than a police officer or police reserve officer in the furtherance of his or her duty, shall ride or operate a bicycle or skateboard, roller-skates or rollerblades, upon a sidewalk in that area bounded by:
 - (1) The north line of Vine Street from Park Street to Second;
 - (2) The west line of Second Street from Vine Street to Oak;
 - (3) The south line of Oak Street from Second Street to Main;
 - (4) The west line of Main Street from Oak Street to "A" Street;
 - (5) The east line of Main Street from "A" Street to Oak;
 - (6) The south line of Oak Street from Main Street to Park; and
 - (7) The east line of Park Street from Oak Street to Vine.
- (b) No person, other than a police officer or police reserve officer in the furtherance of his or her duty, shall ride or operate a bicycle or skateboard, rollerskates or rollerblades, on sidewalks located within the following shopping centers open to the public:
 - (1) Lebanon Plaza:
 - (2) Safeway.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
