ORDINANCE BILL NO. 15

ORDINANCE NO. 2120

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:


Section 1. Chapter 10.24 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to add section 10.24.180 as follows:

"10.24.180. Scheduled Construction and Emergency Repair of City Facilities

- a) No parking shall be allowed in areas of construction or repair of city facilities as deemed necessary by the Director of Public Works or his authorized representative. Temporary "NO PARKING" signs shall be placed at least 12 hours in advance of enforcing this no parking regulation in areas of scheduled construction or repair of city facilities.
- b) For emergency repair of city facilities, all legally parked vehicles and any other lawfully placed obstructions, located within the street right-of-way for which removal has been deemed as necessary to perform the repair, may be towed or removed and stored and the city shall pay all costs associated with said towing and removal. The city shall also pay all the cost of said storage for 24 hours after the owner has received notification of such action."
- c) Unless otherwise provided, this section shall be enforced pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 10.56.


Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
