FEE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.) ORDINANCE NO. 2121

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.12.030 of the Lebanon Municipal Code, Amusement Machines - Fee, is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. From and after November 11, 1992, there is levied and there shall be collected from every person a fee for the act or privilege of engaging in the business of display or operation of amusement machines within the City for gain, benefit or advantage. The fees to be paid for each machine are as follows:

1. \$50.00 per year per machine, due July 1 of each year; or

2. \$5.00 for each month or part of a month remaining in the fiscal year (July 1 through June 30) for any machine placed after July 1. A total amount by this method is due within 30 days after placement of a machine;


B. Any machine placed at a location in place of a moved machine for which the above fees have been paid is exempt.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 11th day of November, 1992.
