ORDINANCE BILL NO. 6
for 1993
ORDINANCE NO. 2130

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lebanon established and administered the EAST GRANT STREET LID in the manner set forth in the Lebanon Municipal Code 12.20.230 and 12.20.240 as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, said Council has resolved that the final cost to be assessed on the benefitting properties is \$22,397; and

WHEREAS, the Assessment Roll set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto, has been filed with the City Recorder; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lebanon has, after providing required notice, held a public hearing for the purpose of considering remonstrances; NOW THEREFORE

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The costs of the EAST GRANT STREET LID shall be apportioned to the individual properties within the boundaries of said LID in accordance with Appendix A.


Section 2. The City Recorder shall enter the assessments thus provided for in the bonded lien docket, which assessments shall be a lien and charge upon the respective lots against which they are placed.
