THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 10.24.180(a) of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to

read:

a) No parking shall be allowed in areas of scheduled construction or repair of City Facilities, along detours caused by such construction or repairs and areas where said construction, repairs or detours cause traffic control difficulties as deemed necessary by the Director of Public Works or his authorized repreasentative. Temporary "NO PARKING" signs shall be placed at least 12 hours in advance of enforcing this no parking regulation in areas of scheduled construction or repair of City Facilities, detours and traffic control difficulties caused by said construction, repairs or detours.

<u>Section 2.</u> Inasmuch as the Provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate

preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency

is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon

its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
