NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Lebanon ordains as follows:

Section 1. Annexation Area. The following contiguous territory is hereby proclaimed to be annexed to the City of Lebanon and zoned as indicated in accordance with the Lebanon Zoning Ordinance No. 1773, and given the zoning of Highway Commercial (CH).

Section 2. Record. The City Recorder shall submit to the Oregon Secretary of State a copy of this Ordinance. The City Recorder shall also send a description by metes and bounds or legal subdivision, and a map depicting the new boundaries of the City within ten (10) days of the


