DECLARING AN EMERGENCY) ORDINANCE NO. 2172

It is hereby ordained by the people of the City of Lebanon, Section 9.04.010, Definitions, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1: As used in this title, the following words mean:

(a) "Disorderly house" means any house or place kept or maintained for the purpose of prostitution or illegal gambling, including any place, room or building used for the consumption, sale or disposition of liquor, narcotics, dangerous drugs, or tobacco contrary to the law.


(b) "Minor" means any person under the age of eighteen years, except as otherwise provided.

(c) "Persons" means a natural person, firm, partnership, association, or corporation, whether the persons or the corporation is acting for himself or itself or as the Clerk, servant, employee, or agent of another.

(d) "Public Place" means a building, way, place, or accommodation, whether publicly or privately owned, open and available to the general public.

Section 2: Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 23 day of August, 1995.
