WHEREAS, Cascades West Council of Governments (CWCOG) was created by an Intergovernmental Agreement on the 1st day of September, 1970, pursuant to ORS Chapter 190; and,

WHEREAS, CWCOG wishes to become an intergovernmental entity and exercise the powers of an intergovernmental entity provided in ORS 190.080; and.

WHEREAS, creation of an intergovernmental entity requires that an intergovernmental agreement be drafted creating the intergovernmental entity, and that each of the parties to the intergovernmental agreement enact an ordinance ratifying creation of the intergovernmental entity prior to the effective date of the intergovernmental agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the attached Articles of Agreement create the Oregon Cascades West Council of Governments ("OCWCOG"), and the City of Lebanon desires to be a party to the attached Articles of Agreement and to ratify the creation of OCWCOG as an intergovernmental entity;

Now, therefore, the people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City of Lebanon intends, by enacting this Ordinance, to approve creation of OCWCOG as an intergovernmental entity by the attached Articles of Agreement, and, hereby ratifies the creation of the Oregon Cascades West Council of Governments as an intergovernmental entity pursuant to ORS 190.085.

<u>Section 2</u>: The effective date of the Articles of Agreement shall be first date on which two thirds of the members of the existing CWCOG, plus one, have adopted ordinances ratifying the creation of OCWCOG as an intergovernmental entity.

<u>Section 3</u>: The public purposes for which the intergovernmental entity is created and the powers, duties and functions of the intergovernmental entity are as set forth in the attached Articles of Agreement.

<u>Section 4</u>: Creation of OCWCOG is necessary in order to refinance CWCOG's existing loan and reduce interest costs. In order to allow the refinancing to occur as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect upon enactment.
