

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING) ORDINANCE BILL NO. 6
SECTIONS 13.04.390 and 13.04.400) FOR 1996
LEBANON MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING)
THE SETTING OF WATER FEES AND)
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY) ORDINANCE NO. 2183

The people of the City of Lebanon ordain as follows:

Section One: Section 13.04.390 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.04.390 User Fee - Domestic User.

A. "Domestic user" means all single-family and individual apartments or flats where service is furnished through a separate meter for each individual apartment.

B. Fees for this class will consist of a basic charge for each size of meter installed and assessed independently of water use, and a commodity charge.

C. An additional rate step may be established for water use at the discretion of the City Council.


Section Two: Section 13.04.400 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.04.400 User Fee - Commercial and Industrial User.

A. "Commercial and industrial user" means all industries, stores, offices, hospitals, schools, churches, mercantile establishments and apartments except those in which service to each apartment is metered separately.


B. Fees for this class will consist of a different minimum charge for each size of meter installed and a commodity charge. For the purposes of computing the commodity rate, all 3/4" and smaller size meters will be considered to be 3/4" meters.
