ORDINANCE NO. 2189

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:


**Section 1.** Section 10.24.130 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**10.24.130 Trucks parking restrictions.**

No person shall park a truck described in Section 10.32.020 on a street other than a street designated in Chapter 10.32 of this code as a truck route; except truck parking is allowed on West Oak Street from Second Street to the west city limits for 10 minutes only.

**Section 2.** Inasmuch as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 9th day of October, 1996.
