
THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Lebanon Municipal Code, Section 10.08.020, Violation of State Statutes Designated Offense Against City Prosecution Authority, is hereby amended to read as follows:


10.08.020 Violation of provisions in Chapters 153, 742, and 801 through 823, inclusive, of the Oregon Revised Statutes, as now constituted, is an offense against the City. The City Attorney shall have the authority to prosecute violations of this Section on behalf of the City.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City or Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council of the City of Lebanon by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 10th day of December, 1997.
