

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ) ORDINANCE BILL NO. 19  
CHAPTER 13.06 OF THE LEBANON, ) for 1998  
MUNICIPAL CODE, CROSS-CONNECTION )  
CONTROL AND BACK FLOW DEVICE )  
INSTALLATION STANDARDS ) ORDINANCE NO. 2235

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted certain standards for cross-connection control and back flow device installation; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance, located in Chapter 13.06, references certain Oregon Administrative Rules; and

WHEREAS, said Oregon Administrative Rules have been amended since the creation of this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Lebanon does ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 13.06.040, Specifications and requirements adopted by reference, of the Lebanon Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The city adopts and incorporates herein by reference the "cross-connection control requirements," dated October, 1997, Oregon Administrative Rule 333-061-0070 with the following amendments:

1. There shall be added to Oregon Administrative Rule 333-061-0070 a subsection (f) which shall read as follows: "The service is larger than two inches."

B. The city adopts and incorporates herein by reference the "backflow assembly installation standards," dated October, 1997, Oregon Administrative Rules 333-061-0071 (Ord. 2111 §§ 7,8, 1992)

**Section 2.** Section 13.06.050, Existing or potential cross-connection-Remedies, of the Lebanon Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. If the city has reasonable cause to believe that an existing or potential cross-connection is located on the consumer's premises, the city shall deny or discontinue water service to those premises which contain an existing or potential cross-connection until:

1. A state-approved back flow prevention assembly or method commensurate with the degree of hazard is installed and approved by the City of Lebanon; or


2. The cause of the hazard is eliminated

B. As backflow prevention assemblies do not allow water to move in a reverse flow, it is the responsibility of the property owner to eliminate the possibility of thermal expansion.

C. Service may either be denied or discontinued if access to the consumer's premises for inspection to determine whether a cross-connection or potential cross-connection exists is denied. (Ord. 2111 § 6, 1992)

**Section 3.** Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon , an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
