
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2269

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.28.045 of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to read:


“The senior and disabled services advisory board, in addition to the nine members appointed by the mayor, will include two rotating community positions. These positions will be comprised of local business representatives. The rotating community positions will be for a term of six months. The rotating community members will be selected and recruited by the consensus of the advisory board. An individual serving as a rotating community member may be re-appointed for a second consecutive term, and may be re-appointed for an additional term two (2) years after the end of his or her original term of office. This section shall apply to those rotating members who are in office on the effective date of this section.”

Passed by the Lebanon City Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against this 23rd day of August, 2000.
