ORDINANCE BILL NO. 2
for 2001
ORDINANCE NO. 2275

WHEREAS, the owners of the property included in the High Priority Sidewalk Project Phase V were notified regarding the requirement to install sidewalks upon the right of way abutting their property within a stated time period; and

WHEREAS, the property owners failed to install the sidewalk within the stated time; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer caused these improvements to occur; and

WHEREAS, accurate cost records were maintained of the expense as it applied to each parcel of land.


THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the costs of the High Priority Sidewalk Project Phase V shall be apportioned to the individual properties in accordance with Appendix A, herein.

Section 2. That the City Recorder shall enter the assessments thus provided for in the unbonded lien docket, which assessments shall be a lien and charge upon the respective lots against which they are placed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after the date this ordinance is signed and approved by the City Council and the Mayor.
