ORDINANCE NO. 3377

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lebanon, by means of Council Resolution No. 6 for 2001, ordered that the City Engineer prepare a Preliminary Engineering Report for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Sidewalk Local Improvement District (LID); and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Council to cause the installation of sidewalk improvements in accordance with said Report, which documents included herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Council further intends to assess upon each lot, or part thereof, abutting the improvements its appropriate share of the cost of said improvements; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on April 11, 2001 and objections and remonstrances were received of property owners representing \_\_\_\_\_\_ percent of the total street frontage within the district; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby establishes and improvement district to be known as the 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Sidewalk LID.

<u>Section 2</u>. The properties included in this improvement district shall be:

Five (5) properties adjacent to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street that are located in Section 15A of Township 12 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Linn County, Oregon and that are more particularly described per Linn County Assessor's information as being:

1.	Map 12-2W-15A	Tax Lot 1400
2.	Map 12-2W-15A	Tax Lot 1501
3.	Map 12-2W-15A	Tax Lot 4101
4.	Map 12-2W-15A	Tax Lot 4200
5.	Map 12-2W-15A	Tax Lot 4416

<u>Section 3</u>. Within said district, each lot, or part thereof, shall be assessed its appropriate share of the costs of the improvements, and such costs shall become liens against the property.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after the date this ordinance is signed and approved by the City Council and the Mayor.
