VACATING DAVID STREET)

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 12
For 2001
ORDINANCE NO. 2285

WHEREAS, as a result of petition from abutting property owners, the City of Lebanon has initiated vacation proceedings for David Street, more particularly described as follows:

An area of land in Section 10 of Township 12 South of Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon described as follows:

All of that portion of David Street lying East of the East right-of-way line of Fifth Street as conveyed, set apart, and dedicated to the use of the public on Royer Addition to the City of Lebanon as recorded in the Linn County Book of Plats in Volume 8- Page 48 on the 31st day of December 1946.

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Lebanon has conducted a public hearing on November 14, 2001, having duly considered the testimony of interested persons and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that notice has been duly given, that the consent of the owners of the requisite area has been obtained, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the public interests will not be prejudiced by the vacation of such public right-of-way;

NOW, THEREFORE, the people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. David Street, more particularly described as follows:

An area of land in Section 10 of Township 12 South of Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon described as follows:

All of that portion of David Street lying East of the East right-of-way line of Fifth Street as conveyed, set apart, and dedicated to the use of the public on Royer Addition to the City of Lebanon as recorded in the Linn County Book of Plats in Volume 8- Page 48 on the 31st day of December 1946.


is hereby declared vacated.

Section 2. A certified copy of this Ordinance vacating the above-described right-of-way on any map in regard thereto shall be filed for record with the County Clerk for Linn County.

Section 3. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be also filed with the County Assessor and the County Surveyor for the County of Linn.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after the date this ordinance is signed and approved by the City Council and the Mayor.
