

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
SECTION 12.04.110 OF THE LEBANON  
MUNICIPAL CODE, TREES,  
INTERFERENCE WITH TRAFFIC**

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

**Section 1.**

Section 12.04.110, Trees – Interference with Traffic, of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

No owner or person in charge of property that abuts upon any street or public sidewalk shall permit trees or bushes on the person's property to interfere with street or sidewalk traffic. It shall be the duty of an owner or person in charge of property that abuts upon a street or public sidewalk to keep all trees and bushes on the person's premises, including the adjoining parking strip, trimmed to a height of not less than eight (8) feet above the sidewalk and not less than thirteen (13) feet above the street surface, or (14) fourteen feet above the street surface on property adjacent to designated truck routes.

**Section 2.**

This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its passage.
