The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows.

Section 1.



Section 8.04.280, Trees – Interference with Traffic, of the Lebanon Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

No owner or person in charge of property that abuts upon any street or public sidewalk shall permit trees or bushes on the person's property to interfere with street or sidewalk traffic. It shall be the duty of an owner or person in charge of property that abuts upon a street or public sidewalk to keep all trees and bushes on the person's premises, including the adjoining parking strip, trimmed to a height of not less than eight (8) feet above the sidewalk and not less than thirteen (13) feet above the street surface, or (14) fourteen feet above the street surface on property adjacent to designated truck routes. Any street tree planted that does not comply with said policy may be removed by the City at the discretion of the Director of Public Works / or his designee. The cost of such removal will be borne by the person or persons who planted the tree.


Section 2.

This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after its passage.
