THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


**Section 1.** Ordinance No. 2059, proscribing the number of dogs allowed per dwelling unit, codified at Lebanon Municipal Code Section 6.12.015, enacted in 1989, is repealed.

**Section 2.** Ordinance No. 2059, repealed by this ordinance, shall remain in force to authorize the citation, prosecution, conviction and punishment of a person who violates Ordinance No. 2059, LMC 6.12.015, prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall become effective thirty days (30) after its passage.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council by a vote of 4 in favor and 0 against and approved by the Mayor on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2010.
