WHEREAS, the Lebanon City Council has reviewed the recommendation of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section F of Lebanon Municipal Code 2.30.060 *Meetings of Members* shall read as follows:


2.30.060 Meetings of Members

- F. Members may resign upon written notice to the Chair. The Chair may ask a member to resign who is absent from three consecutive board meetings, or is absent from five or more meetings in one calendar year, without an excuse approved by the Board. The chair shall declare the non-attending board member's position to be vacant and direct the staff liaison to make public said vacancy, and notify the City Clerk of said vacancy in order to complete the application and selection process.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective thirty days (30) after its passage.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against and approved by the Mayor on this 8th day of September, 2010.
