

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING) ORDINANCE BILL NO. 2011- 6
CHAPTER 6.14 OF THE LEBANON)
MUNICIPAL CODE; DANGEROUS DOGS) ORDINANCE NO. 2819

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon generally establishes fees to cover the cost of providing certain services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon Adopts a City Fees and Charges Schedule by means of a City Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Lebanon Municipal Code section 6.14.040(C) is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.14.040 Regulation of potentially dangerous dogs.

C. Pay an annual fee to the City, as set by the City Fee Schedule, at the time the tag described in subsection B of this section is issued, and a fee as described by same schedule each year thereafter, so long as the dog remains within the corporate limits of the city. This fee shall be in addition to any other license fee required by law;

Passed by the Lebanon City Council by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 against and approved by the Mayor on this 13th day of April, 2011.
