A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5.20.040 OF THE LEBANON MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING LICENSING OF BUSINESSES THAT SELL DRUG PARAPHERNALIA

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon adopted new and amended ordinances regarding the licensing of businesses that sell drug paraphernalia; and

WHEREAS, it was the intent of the City of Lebanon at that time that the distance requirement contained in Chapter 5.20.040 would not apply to any existing businesses, but only prospective businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Lebanon City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the City of Lebanon to amend Chapter 5.20.040 to clearly articulate the prospective intent of that section:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 5.20.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.20.040 Prohibition of Sale in Proximity to Schools. It is unlawful to sell or offer to sell any drug paraphernalia as defined by ORS 475.525 within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising a public or private elementary, secondary or career school attended primarily by minors, excepting businesses who otherwise comply with this Chapter and who were legally conducting business on or before the effective date of this section.
