WHEREAS, LMC 9.18 establishes the Lebanon Alcohol Impact Enhanced Enforcement Area; and
WHEREAS, the area described in Section 1(B) has caused some confusion with the Lebanon Municipal Court and potential Defendants and both the Court and Defendants will benefit from a map "Exhibit A" that includes both exclusion areas in Lebanon.
NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
<u>Section 1.</u> Lebanon Municipal Code Section 9.18.035, Downtown alcohol and impact enhanced enforcement area – Established, is hereby amended to read as follows:
A. A downtown alcohol and impact enhanced enforcement area is established.
B. The boundaries of the downtown enhanced enforcement area shall be Vine Street on the North. Maple Street on the South, Park Street on the East and 2nd Street on the West; the boundaries shall also include that area commonly referred to as the "Lebanon Plaza." Both areas are included on the map attached as Exhibit A.
