

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING) ORDINANCE BILL NO. 2019-3
8.16.200 OF THE LEBANON MUNICIPAL CODE)
RELATING TO UNLAWFUL INTERFERENCE)
OF OR ENTRY INTO WASTE RECEPTACLES) ORDINANCE NO. 2926
AND CREATING PENALTY)

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Franchisee of the City of Lebanon provides trash and recycling receptacles for use by Lebanon residents but retains ownership of all such receptacles at all times; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Lebanon to prohibit unauthorized persons from interference or entrance into solid waste receptacles; and


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 8.16.200 is amended to read

No person, other than the generator of the material contained therein, or an officer, employee or permittee of the City, or an employee of a franchisee shall interfere with any solid waste receptacle serviced by a franchisee, or remove any such receptacle or its contents from the location where the same has been placed by the generator, or remove the lid from any solid waste receptacle, or enter into such solid waste receptacle. A violation of this section is a Class C Misdemeanor.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council and executed by the Mayor on this 13th day of March, 2019 by a vote of 6 yeas and 0 nays.
