Rosco Chairman of Special Committee on  
plans specifications and building Engine House  
made a verbal report of the progress made  
The Records submitted the assessment made  
for a 3 mills tax for Engine house also that  
due notice had been given that the Council  
would sit as a board of equalization at  
this meeting. On examination of said  
assessment by the Council, on motion of  
Councilman Montague the same was  
approved and adapted. On motion the  
Recorder was instructed to notify E. Goen that  
unless his subscription made for buying an  
engine was paid in ten days that suit would  
be instituted in Recorder's Court for the same.

Bill of James McDonald for Lumber Nails  
and Labor in repairing brass and Sidelights and  
bulbets amounting to \$9.04 was presented  
and read. On motion the same was allowed  
and a warrant ordered drawn on the Treasurer  
for the same. The Marshal was further instructed  
to notify property holders of the same and  
collect the amount coming from each.
