Marshal made a verbal report  
as to the collection of the tax  
for an engine house

G. H. Rosco  
Foreman of the Engine Co. submitted  
a quarterly report. On motion  
the same was adopted and a warrant  
ordered drawn on the Treasurer for  
\$ 2.50 in favor of Wm. Riach for  
cleaning engine,

Bill of J. G. Reed  
for lumber \$ 154.37 presented and  
read. On motion the same was  
allowed and a warrant ordered  
drawn on the Treasurer for the  
same.

Bill of W. H. Reed 2000 ft  
of flooring, amount \$ 30.00 presented  
and read. On motion the same  
was allowed and a warrant ordered  
drawn on the Treasurer for the same.

Bill of costs in case of the  
Town of Lebanon vs G. H. Rosco,  
presented by the Recorder and  
read. On motion the same was  
allowed and a warrant ordered drawn  
on the Treasurer for the same, the  
amount being \$ 17.15.

Bill of  
G. M. Miller for assessing the  
Town \$ 18.75 presented and read.  
On motion the same was  
allowed and a warrant ordered  
drawn on the Treasurer for the same.
