 Lebanon Oregon Dec. 1st 1885.
 Council met in regular session
 called to order by the
 President C. H. Kallston, Roll call
 Members Present C. H. Kallston President
 Council men J. H. Rusco, Joseph
 Elkins J. W. Burkhardt and E. E. Mouton
 Marshal and Recorder present
 Minutes of meeting of Oct. 6th read
 and approved. Minutes of meeting of
 Oct. 20th read and there being objection
 to their approval, On motion of
 Councilman Rusco that said
 minutes be approved as read the
 motion being put was declared a
 tie and the President voted in
 the affirmative and declared the
 motion carried and the minutes
 approved. It being the meeting
 for the appointment of judges for
 the annual city election. On
 motion Joseph Nixon, J. W. Cressan
 and R. S. Roberts were appointed as
 said judges and the Recorder
 was instructed to notify said parties
 of their appointment also to give
 the required notice of the time
 and place of said election.

On motion of Councilman
 Rusco a committee of three with
 the President as chairman be appointed
 to take charge of the suit against the
 Town of Lebanon and to effect a
 compromise if possible and to take
 the necessary steps for defending the same

The President appointed G. H. Rusco and Joseph Atkins the other two members of said Committee.

Bill of Burkhardt ~~and~~ and Perren \$18.00 for moving Town jail presents and read. On motion the same was allowed and a warrant order drawn on the Treasury for the same. Bill of J. G. Reed for hauling lumber \$10.65 presented and read. On motion the same was laid on the table.

On motion the Council adjourned to meet Thursday evening Oct. 3.^d at the usual time and place of meeting for the transaction of such business as might come before this meeting.
