Council met in regular session  
called to order by the president J W Harrison  
on call of role the following members

Supt Marshal, minutes of previous meeting  
read & approved, Petition for aid in  
making a ditch in the North end of the Town  
presented & read on motion that the  
Petition be received & placed on file and  
be refered to the committee on health and  
Police, <sup>to make report at next meeting</sup> motion prevailed and it was  
so refered, on motion that when we  
adjourn we adjourn to meet to morrow  
knight the 16 inst, Petition of Andrew  
& Baruthers for side & cross walks pres-  
ented & read & placed on file, <sup>as on motion</sup> ~~and the~~  
~~marshal~~ & the Marshal was instructed  
to notify property owners to build the  
side walks asked for in the petition  
and to build cross walks a cross ash st  
on East of Park st and also a cross park  
st on north side of ash and also  
a cross second st on north side of  
Maple st & also a cross main st on  
north side of rose st & to repair all  
cross walks needing the same the mo-  
tion prevailed & it was so ordered  
on motion that the marshal be in-  
structed to see B H Barbeer and inform

him that there is complaint made a bout  
 boys under age congregating in his shop  
 & letting them play on his table & that he  
 had better stop that kind of a thing the  
 motion prevailed & the marshal was so  
 instructed, on motion the committee  
 on fire & water be instructed to rebuild  
 the bell tower & cut out a side doors bay  
 up the stairway the motion prevailed  
 on motion that the matter of J. H. Stine  
 be postponed untill the next meeting  
 Bill of F. H. Miller for three dollars presented  
 read & allowed & a warrant was ordered drawn  
 on the treasurer for the same which order  
 was drawn, bill of P. A. Lomberson <sup>2.00</sup> <sup>disproving</sup> <sub>for dog</sub>  
 presented & read & allowed & a warrant was  
 ordered drawn on the treasurer for the amount  
 which order was drawn, bill of F. H. Miller  
 for two dollars & fifty cents as Marneys fees  
 in the Gordon case presented & allowed and  
 a warrant was ordered drawn on the treasurer  
 for the amount, the order was drawn, bill  
 of B. H. Dorica for nine dollars & sixty two cts  
 for hauling gravel & making cross walk &c  
 presented & allowed and a warrant was  
 ordered drawn on the treasurer for the amount  
 the order was drawn, bill of M. Bode for  
 eight dollars for cleaning engine & making  
 reel presented & allowed & a warrant was  
 ordered drawn on the treasurer for the  
 amount, the order was drawn, bill of M.  
 S. Roberts for ten dollars for writing minutes  
 & issuing liens presented & allowed and a  
 warrant was ordered drawn on the treasurer  
 for the amount, the order was drawn

there being no further business on motion the  
council adjourned to meet tomorrow night  
at 7 o'clock
