 Council met in regular session
 called to order by the President G W
 Cruson, on call of roll the following
 members were present G W Cruson

 Treasurer J A Roberts absent

minutes
 of previous meeting read & approved
 also minutes of the adjourned meeting
 read & approved the marshal made a
 verbal report about the ~~cross walks~~
 construction of cross & side walks, that
 the same was completed as per instruction
 petition of E Goen & others, ^{presented & read} on motion
 the petition was received & placed on file
 on motion that Grant st be extended East
 from main st to the corporate limits, and
 that that part of the county road be declared
 Grant st the motion prevailed & it was
 so declared, on motion the marshal
 was instructed to notify the parties to build
 the side walks as set forth in the petition
 & that the marshal build the cross walks
 a cross Park st on north side of Grant st
 also to notify E Goen to extend his walk
 from Grant st to Sherman st on east side
 of Park street & that the marshal build a
 cross walk across Sherman street on east
 side of Park street, on motion the
 marshal was instructed to notify
 property owners to build new side

walks on west side of main street in front of the residence of J. A. Lambersons & the Chinese quarters & George Pices, the motion prevailed, Petition of E. B. Montague & others read & on motion was referred to the committee on streets the motion prevailed & it was so referred, bill of F. H. Miller for lumber & hauling the same & other work presented & read & on motion a warrant was ordered drawn on the treasurer for the amount which was 70,31 seventy dollars & thirty one cents on the roads & street funds which was drawn bill of John L. Boid ^{for 900 dis} ^{for 1100 ST} presented & read & on motion there was allowed six dollars for which a warrant was drawn bill of W. B. Torrica for 23, ~~55~~ for lumber presented & read & on motion was allowed & a warrant was ordered drawn for the same which warrant was drawn, on motion the Bill of E. B. Branch for 15,00 dollars was taken from the table & on motion twelve dollars was allowed & a warrant was drawn for the same, and on motion the council adjourned
