 Petition of Edwards & Mayer read and on  
 Motion the same was referred to committee  
 on streets and public Property and it  
 Was so ordered ordinance bill No 30  
 Presented and read first time and by  
 Unanimous consent the bill was put on  
 Second reading on motion the bill was  
 referred to the committee on ordinances on  
 Motion that we now proceed to appoint  
 Judges of the coming Election on motion  
 S M W Hindman Jos Nixon and J H P Hope  
 Were appointed Judges of Election, on motion  
 the Marshall was instructed to procure  
 twenty five hundred feet of crosswalk Lumber  
 Bill of W H Follis for four Dollars for  
 hauling Lumber presented & read and  
 on motion was allowed and a warrant was  
 drawn for the same also Bill of Mayer Bros  
 for Seven Dollars and fifty cents for bolts  
 for Bell tower presented and read  
 and was allowed and a warrant was drawn  
 for the same Bill of F M Miller  
 presented and read and allowed and a  
 warrant was ordered drawn on the  
 Treasurer and a warrant was drawn  
 for Twelve Dollars for hauling gravel

and Lumber and other work  
 Bill of Alfred E Williams for five Dollars  
 for work on Bell tower presented and  
 read & on motion four Dollars was  
 allowed & a warrant was ordered  
 drawn on the Treasurer for the same  
 which order was drawn Bill of  
 A. G. Williams for four Dollars  
 for cleaning engine presented and read  
 and allowed & on motion an order was  
 drawn on the treasurer for the amount of  
 Bill of James Brown for \$2.<sup>50</sup>  
 for labour on engine house presented  
 & read & allowed & on motion an order  
 was drawn for the same Bill of  
 Roscoe & Company for \$13.<sup>73</sup>/<sub>100</sub> for nails &  
 Door ~~Boths~~ <sup>warrant</sup> presented & read and allowed  
 & a <sup>warrant</sup> was drawn for the same also Bill  
 of H. C. Harkness for \$8.75 for labour on  
 engine house & Lumber presented & read  
 and allowed and a warrant was ordered  
 drawn for the same Bill of  
 Churchill & Monteith for \$1.25 for  
 Blankets presented & read & allowed & a  
 warrant was ordered drawn for the same  
 on motion the council adjourned to  
 meet on Tuesday night the 27 of  
 Dec 1887
