Special Meeting

Council met pursuant to call of the Council. The President being absent the Recorder took the Chair.

Roll called minutes of the last meeting dispensed with and the Council proceeded to business.

The position of Night Watch was dispensed with and the Marshal was allowed (\$10⁰⁰) ten dollars extra on his salary to take care of the lamps and to keep them burning till 11 o'clock at night.

The Bills of D D Shaw was examined by the Finance Committee and their Report being favorable the Council ordered warrants drawn on the Treasurer for the same.

On motion of M. A. Miller Phillip Ritter was elected Marshal by the Council for the present.

Mr J C Peedler tendered his resignation as a member of the City.

Council and on Motion of M. A. Miller his resignation was accepted and ordered to be placed on file

This causing a vacancy in the Council Mr. Miller placed J. C. Bilyeu in nomination and J. J. Swan placed J. A. Beard for the office.

and after the vote being taken and Mr. Bilyeu receiving a majority of the votes cast was declared elected to fill the unexpired term —

The Bills of Phillip Ritter R. B. Humphrey Claud Davis and Walter Miller were allowed and warrants on the Treasurer ordered drawn for the same

Council then adjourned till next regular time
