Council met in regular session Roll called President absent and Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved

Mr J. C. Bilyeu to his oath of Office

The Bonds of the Marshal was read and excepted and ordered to be put on file

The Petition A. Dodge and A. J. Williams and others for sidewalk was laid over till next Meeting

On Motion of M. A. Miller Mr. Ritter was appointed Road Supervisor

for the Town of Sebawon

The Council then appropriated sixty \$60<sup>00</sup> dollars more of the Road fund (with the balance of the unexpended fifty), to repair the County Road from the Town Corporation to the Saultain Bridge, under the supervision of the Road Supervisor and Street Committee.

The Street Committee were then instructed to look after the Laups and see that they were tended too.

The Council then ordered the purchase of ten (10) cases of Oil from W.A. Miller at his proposition of "Cost & carriage".

The Bill of Geo W Crusan was referred back for explanation.

The Bill of Crusan & Menzie was referred to the Finance Committee and instructed to have it "stamped".

The Bills of Ritter and Morris were allowed and warrants on the Treasurers ordered for the same.
