was indefinitely postponed

On Motion of J J Sorenson the
sidewalks in front of the Express Office
and the Livery & feed Stable be repaired
or a new one be built—

The Street Committee then
reported in regard to the Lamps
and on Motion of W. A. Miller was
adopted and ordered to be placed
on file

The Bills of E Gove \$2⁵⁰
Phillip Ritter \$13⁰⁰ R R Humphrey in
favor of C B Moulague \$40⁰⁰ and
of W. A. Miller for \$23⁰⁰ was allowed
and warrants ordered drawn on the
Treasurer for the same
