

Lebanon Oregon October 16<sup>th</sup> 1889

Council met in Regular session, Roll called and Members all present

Minutes of the Previous meeting read and approved

The Petition of J C Bilyeu, R. S. W. C. Blure and others for a Sidewalk on the North side of Ash from Main to Railroad Street was granted, and the Marshal ordered to put in the necessary Crosswalks, and also to notify the Property owners to build their portions of the walk.

The Marshal was ordered to see that the sidewalk and Crosswalk between the Harness shop and Livery Stable, running East, were built according to Ordinances

An Ordinance in regard to the Regulation of Bar Rooms passed the first reading and on Motion was laid over till next Regular Meeting

The Marshal was again ordered to notify Property Owners on Main between C. B. Moulague's Store and Livery Stable, running North, to build or repair their Sidewalks and in case it was not done by them, it was on them by Motion of C D Moulague and carried that the Marshal there and there build or repair said walks, and sell property to pay for the said sidewalks

On Motion of J C Bilyeu there was appropriated the sum of Eight \$8.00 dollars to pay for the services of Deputy Marshalls on the 5<sup>th</sup> of October 1889 and a warrant in favor of the Marshal was ordered drawn on the Treasurer for the same
