

Lebanon Oregon Oct. 21 - 1890

Council met in regular session
Roll Called All Members present,
Minutes of previous meeting read and
approved

Marshal Miller reported side-
walk work progressing, and that
all parties had been notified in
accordance with instructions from
the Council.

Committee on streets reported
that they had ordered four new lamps
for streets.

F. M. Miller Road & Street Supervisor
was ordered to buy cross walk lumber
at once for the necessary cross
walks of the town.

On motion the Marshal
was ordered to notify G. J. Cotton to
lower his walk in front of his store
to conform with other adjoining same
and if he did not lower it at
once ~~the~~ the Marshal was ordered to
lower the walk.

Ordinance Bill relating to the
licensing of bar rooms for the
sale and disposal of spirituous liquor
beer and ale: - and to the repeal of
sections 2, 3 & 4, of Ordinance
No 35 was introduced and read
first time.

On motion the rule was
suspended and Ordinance Bill read
second time. It was moved that
the rule be ^{suspended} ~~and~~ ~~On motion~~ the ordinance Bill
be placed on its final passage.
The roll was called for the vote.
The ~~the~~ vote resulted as follows

Motion was lost as it required a unanimous vote to Pass the Bill, the Meeting of its introduction,

On Motion the Bill was referred to the Ordinance Committee for Amendments.
