Council met in regular meeting

was ordered to remove or tear same away at  
the expense of owner,

F. M. Miller Road and Street Supervisor  
made report on street fund of \$247 <sup>75</sup>  
on hand,

On Motion The Treasurer was ordered  
to transfer \$125<sup>00</sup> from Road & street  
fund to City fund for to replace money  
previously drawn from city fund;

Application and Bond of W. J. Guy  
asking for a transfer of City license to  
Guy & Mayer was read.

on the Application & Bond of W. J. Guy & Jale Mayer
