Council met in regular Session. Roll called and Members <sup>all</sup> present.

Minutes of last meeting Read and approved.

Committee on Streets & Public property, reported ~~so~~ that they had caused a number of New street lamps to be placed on the streets, in various localities where the same was most needed. Committee was granted full power to locate lamps where they might think best within the Town.

Joseph Nixon appeared before the Council and was granted leave to speak concerning New walks which he had built contrary to Ordinance ~~to~~ Regulating the constructing & Building of walks.

After making explanation of the reasons & ch. of Building walk as he did.

On motion The Council allowed Joseph Nixon to complete the same, providing he would place three stringers under the New walk to be built and place an additional stringer on out side of walk already built. Nixon showing a disposition to not accept, & complete walks as provided in said motion, The Council
