

Lebanon Oregon Sept 1<sup>st</sup> 1891

Council met in Regular session, Roll called and members all present

Minutes of the last Regular meeting and of the Special read and approved

The Marshal then asked the Council if it was their wish to have the Sunday Ordinance in regard to closing of Saloons enforced - and they instructed him to enforce the Ordinance

Bill No 7 was read the first time and on Motion the Council voting in the affirmative the Bill was read the second time by Pitler

The Poll tax of Mr McElroy was laid on the table

The Bill of J W Fleetwood for City hauling was allowed and a warrant ordered drawn on the Treasurer for the same

The Council then adjourned to meet next Saturday evening Sept 3<sup>rd</sup> 1891
