

Lebanon. Or October 4th 1891

Council met pursuant to adjournment and the Roll called members all present.

The Committee on Sidewalks made their report verbally and the Council then ordered the Marshall to give notice to the Property owners on the North side of Sherman Street from Main Street to Depot Street to put their sidewalks down in accordance with the Ordinances of the City.

And on the West side of Main St. from Ash to Vine st., also from Grant to Sherman on the West side of Second St. and from the Express Office on Main Street to Ash Street on the East Side.

The City Council then authorized the Marshall to see that all sidewalks ordered under the old Ordinances to be put in, and examine all walks in the City limits, and all those not in good condition to notify the owners of the same. He was also ordered to procure six Lump Posts for the City.

On Motion the City Attorney and Recorder was ordered to correspond with Mr. Bretherton of the S P R R Co in regard to a Crossing across the Railroad tracks on Sherman Street.

Mr. Elkins Resolution in regard to draining, was then called up, and on motion it was laid over to the next Regular Meeting adjourned to meet next Tuesday evening Oct-13th 1891
