

Lebanon Oregon October 6th 1891

Roll called and Members all present except
Mr. Matchel -

Minutes of the last Regular meeting
read and approved

The reports of the City officials
of A. Roberts Treasurer and Geo W Rice
Recorder were read and on motion were
ordered to be placed on file

The Resignations of James Matchel -
as Councilman and A W Grubb as City
Marshal was read and on motion were
accepted and ordered to be placed on file

C H Ralston was put in nomination
as Councilman for the unexpired term
and was unanimously elected. The Marshal
then brought him in the Council Room
and was sworn in -

On motion the City Council then ap-
pointed P M Smith City Marshal for the
balance of the Term - His Bonds were
approved and he was sworn in -

The Bonds of S Foley as Street-Commis-
sioner were ordered back to get a Bondsman in
the place of C H Ralston, who becoming a Coun-
cilman was not allowed to remain on -

The Council authorized ~~the~~ Mr Crusan to
purchase for the City another half dozen Street
Lamps also new Burners for the old.

The Marshal was ordered to light the
Lamps at dusk and keep them burning till
11 o'clock P M and he was authorized
to see that a Lamp be put up on the corner
by Mr Guy's place of Business

The Street-Committee was ordered to
to examine all sidewalks and Crosswalks
within the City Limits and report on the

on the same tomorrow evening at half past six —

Mr. Elkins asked for an appropriation of two hundred (\$200⁰⁰) dollars for the purpose of draining the Ponds from Mr. Calley's residence to the ditch at or below the Plains of S. A. Nickerson's — It was laid over to another meeting —

The following Bills were then allowed and warrants ordered drawn on the Treasurer for the same, A W Grubb \$34⁰⁰, Geo W Rice \$38³⁰, S R Blaypool \$6⁸⁰, C E Ranous \$6⁰⁰ and J W Fleewood for \$1³⁵.

The Council then adjourned to meet tomorrow evening at half past six
