

Lebanon Or October 20th 1891

Council met in regular session Roll called and members all present

Minutes of the last regular and Special meetings read corrected and approved

The Special Committee of the whole on Mr Elkins' ^{resolutions} reported verbally and on motion it was laid over to the next regular meeting and in the meantime Mr Elkins was authorized to see what help or assistance he could procure

Mr Peterson, Foreman of the Engine Co made a verbal report in regard to the Fire apparatus

The Hooks that were ordered to be got by a previous meeting not being purchased, on account of being too high in price, the Council ordered the Foreman to get one large Chain hook and two small ones

The Committee on Fire and water was ordered to see that the Engine was repaired and in good working order

Bill No 13 was read the 3^d time and passed the Council voting as follows: G W Crusan, aye, C H Ralston, aye, G M Westfall, aye and for Elkins aye and on motion, the Title of the Bill was to stand as the Title of the ordinance

The following Bills were allowed and warrants ordered drawn on the Treasurer; Crusan & Menzie \$39⁷⁵/₁₀₀; W O Peterson, \$4¹⁵/₁₀₀ M. A. Miller, \$11⁴⁰/₁₀₀ and the Bill of Lumber for 50³²/₁₀₀ from Downing Bros, a warrant was drawn in favor of L Foley Street-Corn on the Road & Street-fund to pay the same

The Council then adjourned to meet on the 21st of October to read and pass ordinances
