

Lebanon Or Nov 17th 1891

Council met in regular Session Roll called and all present

Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

Bills No 16 in regard to Elections was read the first time and on motion which was carried was read the second time by Title, and on motion of C H Ralston was referred to the Committee on Ordinances for amendment

Bill No 17 was then taken up and read the 1st time and on motion was read the second time by Title, and by motion was referred to the Committee on Ordinances for amendment This Bill was for the purpose of amending Ordinance No 13.

Bill No 18 an act to amend Section 3^d of Ordinance No 7 was then read for the first time and on motion was read the second time by title and referred to the Committee on Ordinances for amendment

The City Attorney was instructed to prepare an amendment on vehicles used for carrying or hauling contagious disease or the diseased of any contagious disease

The Marshal was instructed to repair the sidewalk on the City ~~and~~ lot and to repair all sidewalks within the City limits or to see that the same was done

Mr Elkins was asked to see the amount of help the City would receive from property owners in respect to his resolution that is before the Council and to report at their next sittings meeting
