

Lebanon Or Nov 19th 1891

Council met pursuant to adjournment
Roll called and all present

The Committee on Ordinances reported
on Ordinances and on motion their report
was adopted.

Bill No 16 was then read the
3^d time and motion was put on final
passage. The vote of the Council stood
as follows C H Ralston, no, & M Westfall,
no; & W Crusan, yes, and Jos Elkins, yes
The vote being a tie the Mayor for voted for
the Bill. A question being raised in
regard to the Legality of the vote, it was
reconsidered and on motion of C H Ral-
ston it was then again put and the
council all voting for the Bill it was
passed.

On Motion the Title of the Bill was
then declared the Title of the Ordinance

Bill No 17 was then read the 3^d time
and on motion was put on its final passage.
The vote of the Council standing as follows -
C H Ralston, yes, & M Westfall, yes, & W Crusan,
yes, and Jos Elkins yes and on motion
the Title of the Bill was declared to be the
Title of the Ordinance -

Bill No 18 was adopted as amended
and on motion was read the 3^d time
and passed, the Council voting in the
affirmative -

And on motion the Title of the Bill
was declared the title of the ordinance -

Bill No 19 was read the first time and on motion was read the 2nd time by title and referred to the Committee on Ordinances for amendment —

The Committee on Accounts and Currents Expenses reported and recommended the payments of all Bills that had been presented and on motion their report was adopted and the Recorder instructed to issue warrants on the Treasurer for the same —

The Council then appointed S P Bach J G Boyles and E E Montague Judges and W. C. Peterson and A Jack Adams Clerks for the coming election, to be held on the 7th day of December, for City officers

The Council, by motion, then adjourned to meet on next Tuesday evening Nov 24th 1891
