

Lebanon Or December 1st 1891

The Council met in regular session Roll called and members all present Minutes of the last regular and adjourned meetings read and approved

Street-Commissioner L. Foley then made his report and on Motion of C. H. Ralston he was instructed to collect the delinquent-Road tax, or as much as possible, and make his final report at the next regular meeting - the motion being carried -

The request of A. Tripp for a rebate on his mortgage of \$2400.00 on the 90 acre farm of C. F. Wood - to 20 acres at \$27. per acre by showing that only 20 acres being in the Road district - was allowed and the Street Commissioner to rectify the same from funds in his hands

Bill No 19 was then read the 3^d time and passed the Council voting on the Bill as follows, C. H. Ralston, yes; J. W. Crusan, yes; J. O. Elkins, no; and G. M. Westfall, yes, and on motion the title of the Bill was declared to be the title of the Ordinance

Bill No 20 an amendment to Ordinance in regard to License of Hacks trucks and wagons was read the 1st time and on motion was read the 2nd time by title and referred to Committee for amendment -

Mr Elkins Resolution was brought up, also an agreement of property owners was read, agreeing to pay the sums set opposite their names on the Completion of the drain

The Street-Commissioner was authorized to get an Engineer and have a grade established and make a Statement of the cost of the same The expenses to ^{be} equal

paid by the City and the property owners

The Bills of Swan Bros for \$2.⁷⁵ and P M Smith for \$42.⁷⁰ were referred to committee on Accounts & Current expenses —

P M Smith then promised to serve balance of time without compensation, which was accepted by the Council, he was then authorized to allow R S Roberts, Deputy Marshall \$15.⁰⁰ per month for cleaning and lighting of Stamps and services as deputy

J B Gordow, Night-watch, was employed for another at the same salary and he was to perform the same duties as laid down in his first months ~~duties~~ instructions

Council adjourned
